## Chair's report 2024

As in previous years, I start by highlighting a number of the "off field" achievements of the club and will leave the respective Captains to report the "on field" achievements

## The Club has: -

- 1. We started a fourth Saturday team and had for the first time a separate Women's 2<sup>nd</sup> team
- 2. We have refurbished the Main Hall of the Pavilion.
- 3. New TV
- 4. We have converted the outside store to a new umpire's room
- 5. We have installed Solar Panels and are now both using our own electricity and exporting to the grid
- 6. We have constructed a gym facility for use by members.
- 7. Installed solid paths linking the pavilion, gym and nets for year-round access.
- 8. Extended the Wi-Fi and security cameras to cover these new areas.
- 9. The surface of the access road has been improved along with extended parking around the pavilion.
- 10. Coloured clothing was introduced with T20 cricket
- 11. Regular monthly Quiz nights during the winter
- 12. Lily Wood played for Worcester Rapids and is now in Australia playing Grade B woman's cricket. She has also become the first women to play in our Saturday 1<sup>st</sup> team.
- 13. We've had a few players representing the county. Nala Lee has represented Dorset at U13 level and Luke Gould at U10s.
- 14. Taster sessions for Walking Cricket were held at the end of the season
- 15. The 1<sup>st</sup> XI won the Fair play award for Prem 2.
- 16. The indoor winter league has been extended to allow full participation by all players
- 17. The Club tour took place again and was enjoyed by all (some more than others!!).
- 18. We have acquired machinery with a view to continue improving the squares and outfields
- 19. We hosted two County age group matches, Dorset U13's and Dorset U11's.
- 20. A group of club members assisted the Rotary with the erection of tents and marquees on Sandpit field
- 21. A group of members provided support to Swanage Carnival by staffing the Carnival Bar on a packed Friday night
- 22. We have established relations with Lewis Manning and Purbeck Parkinsons who both now regularly use our facilities to provide respite and general support for individuals and their Carers.
- 23. Over 70 members attending the annual awards dinner.
- 24. The Croquet section also continues to thrive with more new members this season.

What a fantastic list of achievements again this year. Many thanks to all those involved in helping to make this possible

You will see, we are proposing a small increase in subscriptions and match fees this year. It has been some years since the last increase and I hope you will agree the membership is still very competitive and reasonable for the facilities on offer.
