- Publicly accept all officials' judgments
- Discourage unfair play and arguments with officials
- Pay membership fees promptly
- Help the **team manager/coach** by notifying availability as early as possible
- Deliver and collect your child punctually to training/matches
- Ensure players are properly dressed for the weather conditions
