GUIDELINES FOR DEALING WITH AN ACCIDENT

Information

- The First Aid Kit is kept in the Kitchen on the top of the cupboard to the left of the sink.
- The Incident / Accident report form is kept in a file on bar next to the trophy cabinet.

Advice

- Stay calm but act swiftly and observe the situation.
- Do not move someone with major injuries. Wait for the emergency medics.
- If there is a risk of further injury, avoid moving the person unless absolutely necessary.
- Listen to what the injured person is saying.
- Alert any qualified First Aider*, who might be present, to take appropriate action for minor injuries.
- In the event of an injury requiring specialist treatment, call the emergency services on **999**.
- Deal with the rest of the group and ensure that they are adequately supervised and safe.
- If the injured person is able to speak, ask if anyone should be advised of their injury. If they are unconscious, be prepared to notify their next of kin / parent / guardian.
- The Captain or Coach should complete an Incident / Accident Report Form.

* Any qualified Coach will have done some First Aid. In 2013 they were:
